- **Hearts swelled**, heads bowed and tears rolled down cheeks as the south honoured Australia's war veterans on Anzac Day. A bumper crowd turned out at the City of Onkaparinga Memorial Gardens at Morphett Vale to attend the 6am dawn service. Morphett Vale RSL president Frank Owen said it was the largest gathering he had ever seen. "It's definitely bigger than last year when we had about 5000. I'd guess there were about 7000 today," he said. Many of the crowd were visibly moved during the service, as they remembered fallen family members and comrades.
- **Speed limits** on a host of southern roads are set to drop from 100km/h to 80km/h next month. The Transport Department has decided to reduce the speed on four of its roads, to bring them in line with a number of other roads being reduced by Onkaparinga Council. The affected roads are: Main Rd between McLaren Vale and Willunga; Maslin Beach Rd between Commercial Rd and Main South Rd; Tatachilla Rd between Main South Rd and California Rd; and, Kangarilla Rd between McLaren Flat and Kangarilla. Onkaparinga Council voted to lower the speeds on 46 rural roads in McLaren Vale, Willunga, Aldinga and Sellicks Hill in July last year. The changes on both the council roads and State Government roads will come in to effect on May 11.
